- Tool expert for Bunnings (commenced 2016)

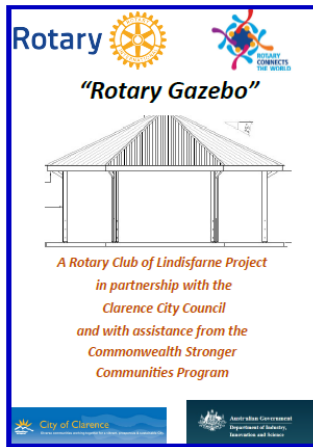
