

Ted Burton - Disaster Aid Australia



Ted Burton, District 9830 Representative for Disaster Aid Australia and a member of the Rotary Club of Youngtown for only 30 years (!), gave a wonderful presentation to members on the activities of this great organisation.

Ted talked about the biggest requirement in any disaster – clean drinking water!

The SkyHydrant is designed and built in Australia and is capable of producing safe drinking water without the need for power or chemicals. It is designed to produce water for 500 – 1,000 people as a standalone unit, for less than \$1 per person per year. A single unit can produce up to 1,000 litres per hour and can produce clean drinking water from the majority of non-saline surface and ground water...and the best bit, it only costs around \$5k installed!!

Ted tempted members with a package deal to visit Bhutan, the land of the Thunder Dragon, with a SkyHydrant in their luggage, and give safe water to 100's of children!!

Thanks Ted, I could see that some Club Members were interested in this travel deal!
