Due to the support of the Rotary Club of Hobart and a Rotary District Designated Fund grant from our district – 9830, we have been able to create four picture guides for our program partner in the Philippines.

Our program partner – The Muravah Foundation have advised "Recently we've launched the " Gulayan sa Barangay" which literally means "Vegetable Garden in the Community". The Muravah Foundation provides seeds and other planting materials in accordance with the Food Guide on hand provided to us in our Food Plants Solutions publications. The Food Guide that we received from FPS is discussed in the Family Development Sessions, conducted once a month in our brand new Community Centre built by Muravah Foundation. It will be very helpful for the parents to know the nutritional value of the food that they serve with their families. Also it will be very beneficial to know the nutritional value of our indigenous vegetable/plants found in our area.
