Looking incredibly fit, Ange talked about Dragon Boating in Tasmania. Ange paddles for Derwent Storm, one of 7 Dragon Boat Clubs in the State. The crew she paddles with take it very seriously and train 4 times a week!

Dragon Boat racing takes place over a number of different courses - 200m, 500m, 1k & 2k (around 4 buoys with 20 second gaps between the crews). Crews are age based 12-18, under 24, 24-40, 40-50, over 60.

Ange has competed in State, National & International competitions and shared photos of some of her great successes along the way. Whilst the sport can be competitive, one of its greatest appeals is working as a team and just having fun!

Thanks Ange for a great insight into a sport that many of us see regularly on the water in Lindisfarne Bay.




