Last Meeting Greg Cooper – Chief Operating Officer, Macquarie Point Development Corporation



Greg is a passionate Tasmanian, who after living & working away for a number of years, moved back to Hobart 17 years ago. He used the slide above to outline developments to date at the Macquarie Point site.

He then went on to talk about the release of Stage 1 “The Escarpment” which, as he pointed out is only 10% of the site, with 50% of the site reserved for “Open Spaces”. There will also be car parking provided for up to 600 cars under “The Park”. By 2025 the Corporation expects up to 9,800 people to be employed working on the site.



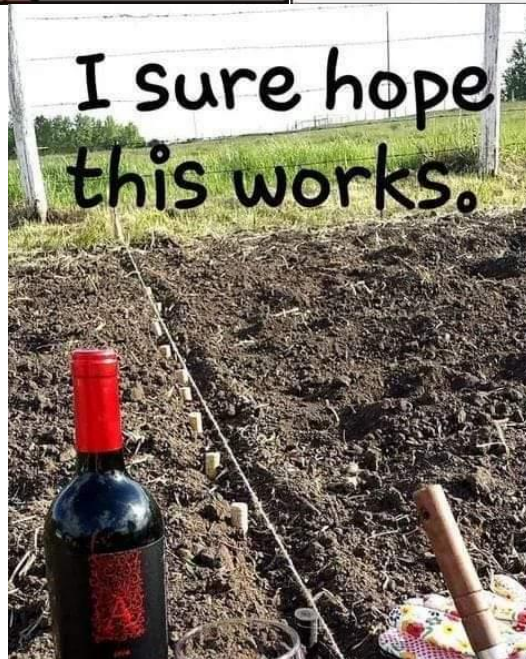
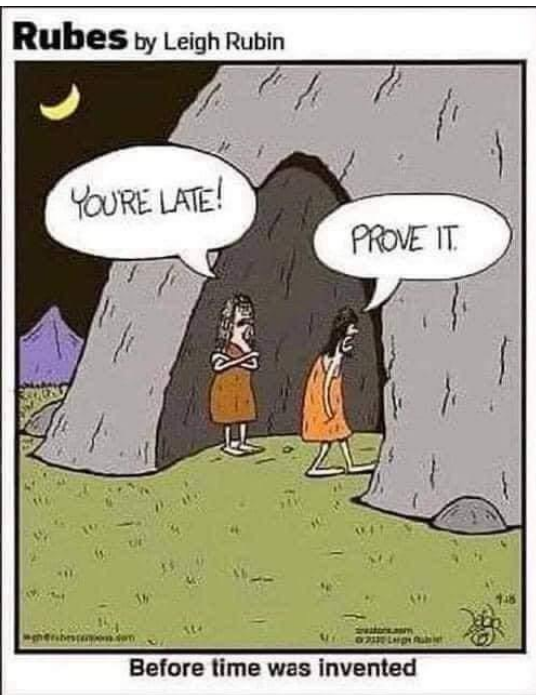
You have the option between a full day experience (\$100 per person) or the choice of half a day (\$60 per person), stopping in Richmond for a pub lunch.
