

Thank you for those who have replied to the survey I sent out. Mainly I wanted to cover off on what the vaccination status is with the membership and the venue and catering preference for physical meetings. I will go through the results on Wednesday.

It is with regret that we have cancelled Trash and Treasure yet again. This time due to the difficulties with running a safe event during a pandemic. The Charity Dinner and Auction planned for April has not been cancelled, but will be moved to a date to be determined later this year. Another Rotary event, which you would have received an email on, is the District Conference, this has been rescheduled as well.

You would have all heard about the volcano eruption and tsunami disaster in Tongo. Tonga was severely damaged from the tsunami and immediate assistance is required to re-establish communications, transport and to provide clean water and food.

In response to the disaster Rotary Australia World Community Service (RAWCS), in partnership with their New Zealand counterparts, have set up an appeal with the aim of raising \$1,000,000. The appeal is to provide both immediate and long-term assistance to the Tongan community. The Club has donated \$600 to the appeal and will make a further donation from the net proceeds of the Bunnings BBQ scheduled for the 12th of February. An advance thanks you to those who will be running this BBQ.

Also, thanks to the Members who helped out at the vaccination clinic for the kiddies at Clarence High School. From the feedback I received, the assistance was very much appreciated and the kiddies were better behaved than the adults!


BREAKING NEWS:
