Catherine N has agreed to organize the catering for this week and Amanda E for the following meeting (16 March). Would someone like to help them, if so please contact them directly?

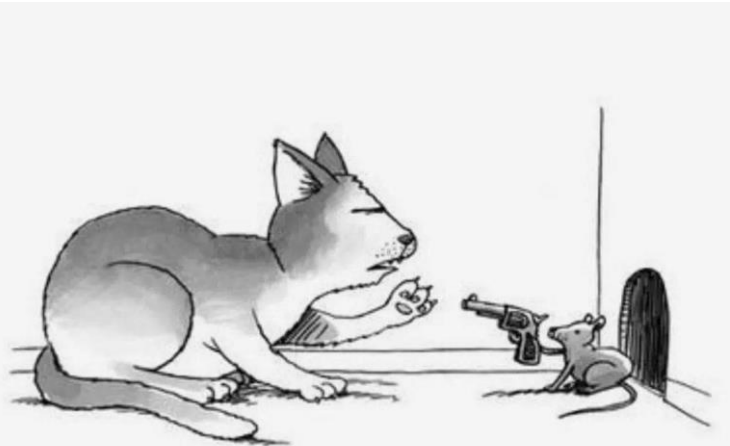
