Richard, as a member of the District Regionalization Pilot Project Team, spoke to members about this Project.

In summary, Rotary International is considering a project in our region (Zone 8 – Australia, New Zealand, and Pacific Island countries) to address membership, public image, communication, leadership, and fundraising challenges to help define a more sustainable future for Rotary.

Five key objectives for the project are:

- Support clubs to engage members, volunteers and communities
- Create new attractive leadership opportunities
- Build a stronger unified Rotary brand
- Encourage partnerships
- Improve efficiencies and reduce duplication

The Club, through President Stephen, gets a vote on whether they would like to see the project started. Remember, this is a vote to explore change and not a vote for any actual change, at this stage. Voting will occur during September.

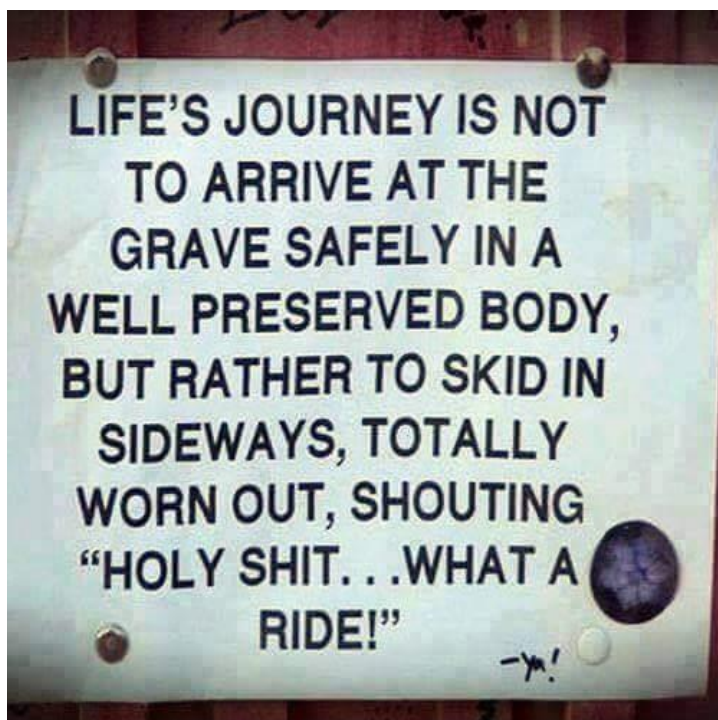
